Exploratory Classes (Semester in Length)

Ag, Food, and Natural Resources

This course is designed to assist middle school students in understanding the relationship between agriculture and science. Major concepts covered in the course include an awareness of agriculture, the world of work, agri-business careers, human relations, and scientific principles applied to agriculture.

Middle School Computers

Students will work to improve keyboarding speed, control, and accuracy by using an online game called Nitrotype. They will learn computational thinking and creativity by coding and problem solving using programs like Word, Power Point, Excel and Publisher along with internet-based programs. Students will be able to insert tables, Internet graphics, word art, auto shapes, and text boxes. They will be able to write formulas, use functions, make charts and graphs along with using a variety of media for presentations.

Building Technology

Students will learn about shop organization, types of wood and other materials, tools, safety and project construction. At any given time you will see students gluing up projects and working at the workbench sanding or using hand tools. Proper use of woodworking tools will be demonstrated and practiced. Planning and building projects and developing good safety habits are most important skills learned in the class.

Middle School Art

Students will learn fundament concepts of art. This class will cover areas such as drawing, painting, sculpture, and art concepts. The skills learned will allow student to be more successful as they transition through middle school and enter high school art courses.
